

# EuCon Adapter for Cubase 6 - Installation

---

This document provides instructions regarding the order of installation of all components required for use of Cubase 6 in conjunction with the AVID Artist Series controller

General installation order/overview:

- > Cubase 6: installation DVD
- > EuControl software application
- > EuCon Adapter installer

Please follow the detailed steps below:

1<sup>st</sup> step:

Install your Cubase 6 program using the Cubase 6 installation DVD.

2<sup>nd</sup> step:

Install one of the following software packages on your computer running Cubase:

- “EuControl Software Package Version 2.5.6”** for Mac OS X 32-bit & 64-bit & Cubase 6
- or
- “EuControl Software Package Version 2.5.7 32bit”** for PC Windows 32-bit & Cubase 6 32-bit
- or
- “EuControl Software Package Version 2.5.7 64bit”** for PC Windows 64-bit & Cubase 6 32- & 64-bit

3<sup>rd</sup> step:

The Steinberg EuCon Adapter is installed by executing the EuCon Adapter installer.

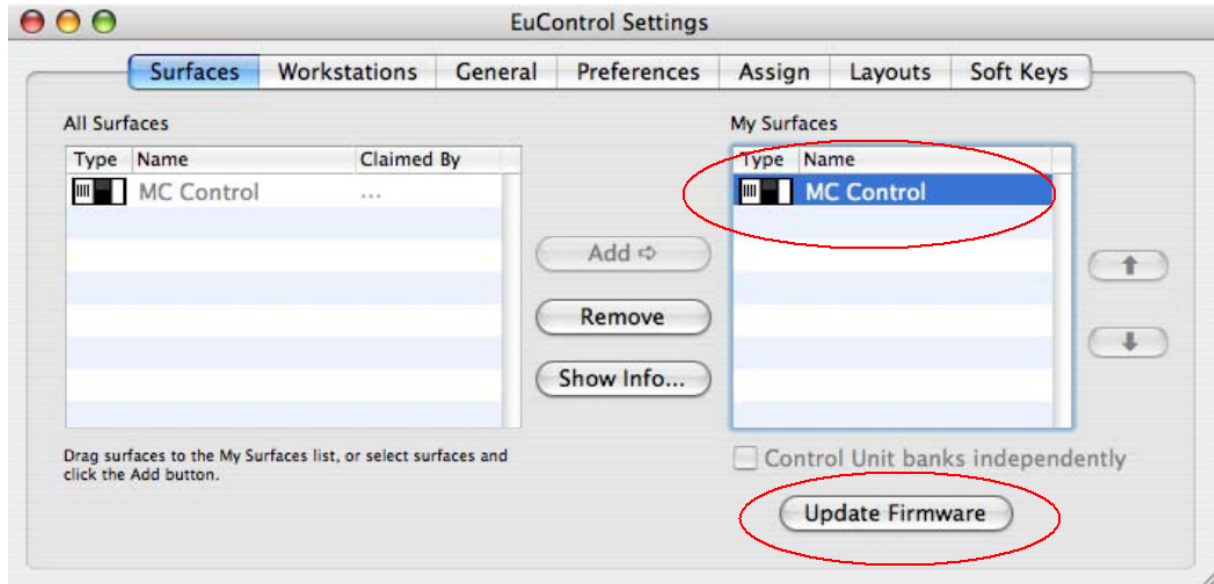
To do so, install one of the following software packages:

- “Steinberg EuCon Adapter 6.0.mpkg”** for Cubase 6 on Mac OS X 32-bit & 64-bit
- or
- “SteinbergEuconAdapter60\_32bit.msi”** for Cubase 6 32-bit on PC Windows 32-bit & 64-bit
- or
- “SteinbergEuconAdapter60\_64bit.msi”** for Cubase 6 64-bit on PC

4<sup>th</sup> step:

Please update the firmware for your Artist Series controller by selecting the connected surface in the EuControl Settings under “My Surfaces” and clicking the “Update Firmware” button.

Example:



Follow the instructions on screen.

5<sup>th</sup> step:

Start Cubase 6 and add “EuCon” to the Remote Devices in Device Setup. Make sure that your Artist Series surface is connected to your computer and recognized by the EuControl software. Load your Cubase project.

For Mac users, restart the EuControl software to see the correct Cubase 6 functions on the MC Control touch screen.

**Important:** Please check the compatibility of the required components.

The following versions are compatible and have been tested:

Cubase 6.0.0.229

EuControl Software Package Version 2.5.6 (Mac)

or

EuControl Software Package Version 2.5.7 (PC)

EuCon Adapter 6.0.0.107

**Important:** This installation description is only valid for Cubase 6 users.

### De-installation:

#### PC

To deinstall the EuCon Adapter:

Open: System Settings > Control Panel > Programs > Programs and Features:  
Select "Steinberg Eucon Adapter 6.0" and "Uninstall".

#### Mac

To remove the EuCon Adapter, you are required to manually delete the "eucon60.bundle" file found under:

System hard disk > Library > Application Support > Steinberg > Components.

### EuCon Artist License:

If you do not have a "Eucon Artist" license on your Steinberg Key (USB-eLicenser) already (required if you want to run the EuCon Adapter and Artist Series controller with Cubase or Nuendo), continue with the following instructions:

- 1) Create a user account in the MySteinberg area of the Steinberg web site. If you already have a MySteinberg account and have already registered your version of Cubase, continue with Step 4.
- 2) Check your email and activate your user account by clicking the link in the confirmation email.
- 3) Enter your MySteinberg account, click on Product Registration, choose Register Product and select Product with Steinberg Key or Soft-eLicenser. Register Cubase.
- 4) Enter your MySteinberg account. Click on Activation & Reactivation, choose Euphonix Artist Series EuCon Adapter and select Permanent Activation. Enter your Artist Series controller's serial number. You will receive an email containing the activation code.
- 5) Launch the eLicense Control Center (eLC) software from the Applications folder, click "Enter Activation Code" and follow the instructions.
